Department Information

- As of the next term (2nd semester), students will register for their own courses.
- In order for students to take the mid-term/end-of-year or internship exam of a course, they must attend at least 70% of the theoretical courses.
- Students take at least one mid-term exam and a final exam each semester. However, projects, seminars, field studies, quizzes, homework, internships, laboratories and similar mid-term studies can also be done with the decision of the relevant units. Mid-term studies and final exam grades are given out of 100 points.
- The contribution of the final exam to the letter grade is 60%. It is mandatory to get at least 40 points out of 100 points in the final exam. Students who do not take the final exam or who cannot get at least 40 points from this exam are given a letter grade of (FF). A student who is absent cannot take the final exam.
- Students can take make-up exams for all courses they failed in the midterm/end-of-year exam, conditionally passed with a (DC) letter grade, or did not take the midterm/end-of-year exam. At the graduation stage, students with a GPA of at least 2.00 are also considered successful in courses they received a (DC) letter grade. Students can repeat these courses to increase their grades.
- Our department's education and training activities consist of 8 semesters. During these semesters, students are provided with theoretical information in the fields of accounting, marketing, management and economics, as well as theoretical information in the banking and finance sector. In addition, there is a 30-day internship application for our students to gain practical knowledge and skills.
- If our students meet the necessary conditions, they can do a double major or a minor, and they can also continue a certain part of their education at universities abroad with which our university has agreements within the framework of the Erasmus program, thus adding vision to themselves.

Master's program

Thesis-based master's program consists of at least seven courses, one seminar course, and thesis work, with a total of not less than twenty-one credits. The seminar course and thesis work are non-credit and are evaluated as either successful or unsuccessful.

Doctoral program

- The doctoral program consists of at least seven courses, one seminar course, proficiency, 2 developmental learning courses, and thesis work, with a total of not less than twenty-one credits. The seminar course and thesis work are non-credit and are evaluated as either successful or unsuccessful.
- In each semester that the student renews his/her registration during the course phase, he/she can take at least 3 and at most 15 credit courses. (4 courses + ethics course)
- The student can take other courses from the same group instead of the elective courses he/she failed.
- In the thesis MA, students who cannot successfully complete the credit courses and seminar courses in the curriculum at the end of 4 semesters or who fail in the thesis work within the maximum period or who do not defend their thesis will be dismissed from the Institute.
- The maximum period for successfully completing the credit courses required for the doctoral program is four semesters for those accepted with the thesis master's degree. Students who cannot successfully complete their credit courses within this period or who cannot achieve the minimum general grade point average required by the University will be dismissed from the Institute.
- In the mid-term application for a course, at least one mid-term exam is given during the semester. In addition to mid-term exams, projects, homework, laboratory, practical and similar studies can be evaluated as mid-term work. Mid-term exams contribute 40% to the course success grade. The contribution of the mid-term work evaluation grade to the success grade cannot exceed 20%.
- Students who fulfill the attendance requirement and are successful in the practical courses can take the mid-term exam. Students who fail to meet these requirements are not allowed to take the mid-term exam and are given a (D) absent letter grade. The contribution of the mid-term exam to the letter grade is 60%.
