Department of Finance and Banking

In line with globalization and technological advancements, the financial sector is undergoing significant transformation, with the scope of operations of banks and financial institutions continuously expanding. As Turkey aspires to become a financial center, the demand for well-trained professionals with strong analytical skills and a commitment to teamwork is steadily increasing. Currently, nearly 70% of all financial activities in Turkey are carried out by the banking sector, while insurance and other financial services hold substantial growth potential.

The Department of Finance and Banking was established in the 2019–2020 academic year, admitting its first cohort of 40 students. Our mission is to educate individuals who respect human values, possess the knowledge and qualifications required by the profession, and adhere to professional ethical principles in order to meet the sector's growing need for qualified personnel.

The undergraduate program in Finance and Banking consists of 8 semesters. In addition to comprehensive theoretical knowledge in finance and banking, students also acquire a solid foundation in accounting, marketing, management, and economics. Furthermore, a wide range of elective courses focusing on personal development allows our students to enhance their skills and broaden their perspectives.

In order to equip our students with practical knowledge and skills, a mandatory 30-business-day internship program is implemented. Provided they meet the necessary requirements, students may also pursue double major or minor programs. Additionally, through the Erasmus exchange programs, they can study for a period of time at partner universities in Turkey or abroad, thereby broadening their vision and gaining international experience.

Graduates who successfully complete the Finance and Banking program have wide career opportunities. With the education and qualifications they acquire, they may be employed as financial analysts, financial consultants, or portfolio managers in banks and insurance companies, as well as in leasing, factoring, forfaiting, and private pension companies, and in the accounting and finance departments of corporations.

Graduates who wish to pursue an academic career may continue their postgraduate education and, upon fulfilling the necessary requirements, work as faculty members in Departments of Finance and Banking or in related disciplines at universities.
